It was so common that King Solomon “made cedars as abundant as the sycamores which are in the lowland”(I Kings 10:27). This tree belonged to the family of the fig tree and had nothing in common with the sycamore of North America. David appointed an overseer for these trees in the lowland. (I Chron 27:28). Amos identifies himself as a ‘tender of sycamore fruit’.
